Allegheny Children's Initiative +++

Key Services: Students who may need higher level care.

Referrals: ACI team provides follow up + resource recommendations to families. Opens the door to various services in Allegheny County.

01

Counseling Initiative +++

Key Services: Outpatient therapy (k-12th) for students + family

Referrals: Accepts Private Insurance.

03

Caring Place +++

Key Services: Peer support group(s) for grieving children (W, TH)

Referrals: Grief/Loss. See Social Worker/Counselor.

05

MHY Family Services +++

Key Services: Therapy (no insurance required, all ages), resource assistance, case management, crisis intervention, program coordination.

07

Café Momentum +

Key Services: Internship, case management, academic help, MH support, drug/alcohol counseling

Referrals: Probation, adjudication, court fees/fines, truancy, etc. Accept IEP students as well.

09

Pressley Ridge +++

Key Services: CSBBH (k-6th) and Outpatient therapy (k-12th)

Referrals: CSBBH-Intensive service in/out of school. Outpatient- x1 a week during school hours + family therapy options. Accepts Medicaid.

02

UpStreet PGH +

Key Services: Outpatient therapy

Referrals: No insurance required, must be over 14.

04

Allegheny Family Network +++

Key Services: Parent to parent mental health support, case management, advocacy

Referrals: Mental health support for families of children with behavioral health needs.

06

Connections for Youth +++

Key Services: Direct Service Coordination, case management, advocacy

Referrals: Diversion to Juvenile Justice + Child Welfare students, magistrate, probation

08

HSAO +

Key Services: Service coordination for families with high level needs.

Referrals: SAP team, 7th-12th grade at this time.
